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Information for Contributors

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The journal publishes original research articles, review articles, short communications dealing with the aspects of nutrition and letters to the editor.

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Articles written in English are accepted on the understanding that they are subject to editorial revision. Manuscripts should be submitted in quadruplicate, type written, double spaced on one side of good quality paper.

A covering letter stating the name of paper, running head and name of co-authors (if any) from the first author who will be responsible for correspondence is essential. Articles are accepted for publication only when they are submitted solely to this journal. The top page should include title with name and address of the contributor (s). Introduction, Materials and Methods, Results, Discussion, Summary, Acknowledgements and References should be started from second page.

References

References should be indicated by consecutive numbers in superscripts in the text and listed sequentially in the bibliography. Examples of format of (1) a periodical and (2) a book follow :
