## **Information for Contributors**

### **BANGLADESH JOURNAL OF NUTRITION**

The Bangladesh Journal of Nutrition is published in December of the year by the Institute of Nutrition and Food Science, University of Dhaka 1000, Bangladesh. The journal publishes original research articles, review articles, short communications dealing with the aspects of nutrition and letters to the editor. Articles are accepted for publication only when they are submitted solely to this journal.

#### **Manuscripts**

Manuscripts should be submitted in quadruplicate, type written, double spaced on one side of good quality paper. The manuscript should be prepared in the following sequence:

- **Title page** : The title page should include title of the article with name and address of the contributor (s), address of the author responsible for correspondence, sub-title, -
- **Abstract and key words** : Abstract should state the purpose of the study, basic procedures, main findings and conclusions. Key words should be provided below the abstract.
- **Text**: the text should follow the following sequence : (1) Introduction (2) Materials and Methods (3) Results and (4) Discussion,
- Acknowledgements
- References

#### **References**

References should be indicated by consecutive numbers in superscripts in the text and listed sequentially in the bibliography. Examples of format are:

- **Journals**: Cook JD, Dassenko SA and Lynch SR. Assessment of the role of non-heme iron availability in iron balance. *Am J Clin Nutr* 1991; 54: 717-22
- **Books**: Longencker JB. *Newer Method of Nutritional Biochemistry*. Academic Press Inc New York 963: 113.
- **Chapter in Book**: Abdullah M, the effect of seasonality on Intra-household Food Distribution and Nutrition in Bangladesh. In: Sahn DE. ed. *Seasonal variability in Third World Agriculture-The Consequences for Food Security*. The Johns Hopkins University Press. 1989: 57-65.
- **Agency publication**: World Health Organization. *Who Technical Report Series No. 724. Energy - and protein requirements: Report of a Joint FAO/WHO/UNU Expert Consultation*. WHO. Geneva 1985.

#### **Tables**

Tables should be carefully constructed so that the data presented may be understood easily. All tables must be referred to in the text by arabic numerals in consecutive order. Every table and every column should be supplied with an appropriate heading. The table number and the title should be placed in a continuous heading above in the data presented.

#### **Figures**

Figures must be good quality drawings on white drawing paper or photograph prints on glossy paper with strong contrasts or high quality laser printed copies. The original and three copies of the figures should be submitted. Figures should be referred to in the text by consecutive. Arabic numerals as Fig. 1, Fig. 2 etc. Same data should not be used in both tables figures.

#### **Nomenclature and Abbreviations**

Standard abbreviations such as mg, C.F. should be used. Terms such as electrocardiogram, ultra-violet should be written in full first time followed by accepted abbreviation (ECG, UV).

#### **Submission**

A covering letter from the author responsible for correspondence, stating the title of the paper, running head and name (s) of co-authors (if any) is essential. After reviewing if the article is accepted or publication the corresponding author is to submit two finally corrected copies with a floppy diskette containing the article. All Communications related to the journal should be addressed to the Editor, Bangladesh Journal of Nutrition, Institute of Nutrition and Food Science, University of Dhaka, Dhaka-1000, Bangladesh.
